## **REGULATIONS OF ENTRY**

**48 (A)** All applications for registration for the purpose of classification must be received by the Secretary at least seven (7) days prior to the date fixed for the closing of entries in respect of any meeting.

**N.B.** Unless otherwise specified in the conditions of a race, classification allowances shall not be cumulative to the extent of more than 20lb.

**N.B.** In all races advertised for 1100 metres, where they are more than ten (10) starters the Steriline starting gates will be substituted for the Jack Gill starting gates.

### **N.B. DECLARATION OF STARTERS**

In any race declaration must be made at the Registry Office by 10:00AM two days prior to the scheduled day of the race or at such time and date as the Stewards may prescribe.

**7. 1(a)(i)** In all races declaration of jockeys/apprentices must be made at the Registry Office by 10:00AM on the day fixed for declaration to run or at such time and date as the Stewards may prescribe. The declaration of a jockey/apprentice shall be accompanied by an engagement/retainer form which must be signed by a jockey or his agent and the Trainer/Owner/Authorised or Registered Agent and shall state the bodyweight at which the jockey contracts to ride (Rule 50(C) (i)).

**7. 1(a)(ii)** In any race where a horse is a reserve starter a rider need not be declared until such time as the horse becomes an assured runner. At this time the rider must be declared as soon as possible and the engagement/retainer form submitted to the Registry Office at the time of such declaration. If the Stewards consider that there has been any unreasonable delay in declaring a rider and submitting the engagement/retainer form they may deem the horse a non-starter.

**7. 1(a)(iii)** No jockey/apprentice may be changed without the permission of the Stewards after 1.00PM on the day fixed for declaration to run. As a condition of entry, the Owners of all horses entered agree that in the event of a jockey/apprentice not having been declared by the aforesaid time and the engagement/retainer form not submitted the horse shall be deemed a non-starter.

**N.B.** **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR HORSES WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN PASSED AT THE STARTING GATE BY THE STARTER OR HIS SUBSTITUTE OR AS THE STEWARDS MAY PRESCRIBE.**

**NB.** **ALSO, ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR HORSES WHICH ARE NOT VACCINATED AS REQUIRED UNDER APPENDIX 10-6; 6.1; 6.2; 6.3; 6.4; 6.5; AND 6.6 AND RULE 38B (f) AND (g) OF THE RULES OF RACING OF THE BARBADOS TURF CLUB OR AS THE STEWARDS MAY PRESCRIBE.**

**N.B.** If a race is made null and void the horses that have taken entry may take entry in another race on the programme for which the horse is eligible.

This new entry must be made along with any increase to the entry fee no later than 3:00PM on the day of general entry or at such time and date as the Stewards may prescribe.

Horses that take entry in more than one race on a given day need only to pay one jockey insurance fee (\$7.00) with their entry fee.

### **N.B. RE SPLITTING OF RACES**

1. The Stewards of the day may give consideration to splitting a race provided that 18 or more horses have been declared for the race for which such consideration will be given.
2. There will be no splitting of Classic, sponsored or special races.
3. On programmes that offer eight races or more, races that are split taking the number of races to nine or more, 25% will be added to the advertised stake which will then be divided equally between the two races.

**Sub-class allowances at the rate of 5lb for each sub-class to a maximum of 20lb.**

**Unraced horses and horses which have raced and placed 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any of their last three or less starts to carry the allotted weight.**

**Horses which have raced and NOT placed 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any of their last three or less starts allowed 5lb**

**NOTE: IF AFTER THE CLOSE OF ENTRY AND/OR DECLARATION; OR ON RACEDAY, SUBJECT TO RULE 90B, THE WEIGHTS OF THIS RACE HAVE TO BE RAISED OR LOWERED, IT SHALL BE DONE UTILIZING THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE: -**

- 1. ONCE THE LOWEST WEIGHTED ENTRY IS RAISED TO THE MINIMUM BOTTOM WEIGHT OF 104LB; OR IF THE LOWEST WEIGHTED ENTRY IS ORIGINALLY ALLOTTED THE MINIMUM BOTTOM WEIGHT OR A WEIGHT ABOVE THE MINIMUM BOTTOM WEIGHT OF 104LB, THEN THE TOP WEIGHTED ENTRY, WHERE POSSIBLE, SHALL NOT BE INCREASED TO THE MAXIMUM TOP WEIGHT OF 129LB.**
- 2. IF THE LOWEST WEIGHTED HORSE(S) IN THIS RACE ARE ALLOTTED A WEIGHT ABOVE THE MINIMUM BOTTOM WEIGHT OF 104LB AND THE HIGHEST WEIGHTED HORSE(S) ARE ALLOTTED A WEIGHT ABOVE 127LB THEN THE WEIGHTS SHALL BE LOWERED TO ACCOMMODATE A TOP WEIGHT OF LESS THAN 129LB.**
- 3. THE MINIMUM TOP WEIGHT FOR THIS RACE SHALL BE 126LB.**

- (i)
  - a. If at the close of entries and/or declarations; or on raceday, subject to Rule 90B, the highest weight be allotted to a 5-year-old or older horse and be less than 129lb in the case of horses, colts or geldings or 126lb in the case of mares or fillies, then it shall be raised to either 129lb or 126lb, whichever comes first, and all other weights shall be raised equally; or
  - b. If the highest weight after entry and/or declaration; or on raceday, subject to Rule 90B, be allotted to a 4-year-old and be less than 127lb in the case of colts; geldings or fillies, then it shall be raised to 127lb and all other weights shall be raised equally.
  - c. If the highest weight after entry and/or declaration; or on raceday, subject to Rule 90B, be allotted to a 3-year-old and be less than 126lb in the case of colts, geldings or fillies, then it shall be raised to either 126lb, and all other weights shall be raised equally.
  - d. If the highest weight after entry and/or declaration; or on raceday, subject to Rule 90B, be allotted equally to a horse, colt or gelding and a filly or mare and the weights have to be raised, it shall be raised to that applicable to the horse, colt or gelding.
  - e. If the highest weight after entry and/or declaration; or on raceday, subject to Rule 90B, be allotted equally to a 5-year-old or older horse and a 4-year-old and/or 3-year-old and the weights have to be raised, it shall be raised to the weight applicable to the 5-year-old or older horse.
  - f. If the highest weight after entry and/or declaration; or on raceday, subject to Rule 90B, be allotted equally to a 4-year-old and a 3-year-old and the weights have to be raised, it shall be raised to the weight applicable to the 4-year-old horse.
