REGULATIONS OF ENTRY

48 (A) All applications for registration for the purpose of rating must be received by the Secretary at least seven (7) days prior to the date fixed for the closing of entries in respect of any meeting.

N.B. Unless otherwise specified in the conditions of a race, rating allowances shall not be cumulative to the extent of more than 20lb.

N.B. In all races advertised for 1100 metres, where they are more than ten (10) starters the Steriline starting gates will be substituted for the Jack Gill starting gates.

N.B. DECLARATION OF STARTERS

In any race declaration must be made at the Registry Office by 10:00AM two days prior to the scheduled day of the race or at such time and date as the Stewards may prescribe.

7. 1(a)(i) In all races declaration of jockeys/apprentices must be made at the Registry Office by 10:00AM on the day fixed for declaration to run or at such time and date as the Stewards may prescribe. The declaration of a jockey/apprentice shall be accompanied by an engagement/retainer form which must be signed by a jockey or his agent and the Trainer/Owner/Authorised or Registered Agent and shall state the bodyweight at which the jockey contracts to ride (Rule 50(C) (i)).

7. 1(a)(ii) In any race where a horse is a reserve starter a rider need not be declared until such time as the horse becomes an assured runner. At this time the rider must be declared as soon as possible and the engagement/retainer form submitted to the Registry Office at the time of such declaration. If the Stewards consider that there has been any unreasonable delay in declaring a rider and submitting the engagement/retainer form they may deem the horse a non-starter.

7. 1(a)(iii) No jockey/apprentice may be changed without the permission of the Stewards after 1.00PM on the day fixed for declaration to run. As a condition of entry, the Owners of all horses entered agree that in the event of a jockey/apprentice not having been declared by the aforesaid time and the engagement/retainer form not submitted the horse shall be deemed a non-starter.

N.B. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR HORSES WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN PASSED AT THE STARTING GATE BY THE STARTER OR HIS SUBSTITUTE OR AS THE STEWARDS MAY PRESCRIBE.**

NB. **ALSO, ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR HORSES WHICH ARE NOT VACCINATED AS REQUIRED UNDER APPENDIX 10-6; 6.1; 6.2; 6.3; 6.4; 6.5; AND 6.6 AND RULE 38B (f) AND (g) OF THE RULES OF RACING OF THE BARBADOS TURF CLUB OR AS THE STEWARDS MAY PRESCRIBE.**

N.B. If a race is made null and void the horses that have taken entry may take entry in another race on the programme for which the horse is eligible.

This new entry must be made along with any increase to the entry fee no later than 3:00PM on the day of general entry or at such time and date as the Stewards may prescribe.

Horses that take entry in more than one race on a given day need only to pay one jockey insurance fee (\$7.00) with their entry fee.

N.B. RE SPLITTING OF RACES

1. The Stewards of the day may give consideration to splitting a race provided that 20 or more horses have been declared for the race for which such consideration will be given.
2. There will be no splitting of Classic, sponsored or special races.
3. On programmes that offer eight races or more, races that are split taking the number of races to nine or more, 25% will be added to the advertised stake which will then be divided equally between the two races.

THE DIAMONDS INTERNATIONAL/AUDEMARS PIGUET 2009 2-YEAR-OLD SERIES OF RACES

A three-part series of races for West Indian bred two-year-old horses.

Part 1 – Two (2) races on the same day; one for colts and geldings, the other for fillies, over 1000 metres.

Part 2 – Two (2) races on the same day; one for colts and geldings, the other for fillies, over 1100 metres.

Part 3 – One race for colts, geldings and fillies over 1570 metres.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

This series is open to West Indian bred two-year-olds of 2009.

The conditions governing entry into the 2009 Diamonds International/Audemars Piguet 2-Year-Old Series of Races will be as follows:-

1. Horses which passed through the Barbados Turf Club's 2-Year-Old Sale on 6 November, 2008, and horses which did not enter the sale but who's Owners paid the \$1,500.00 fee are eligible for the \$100,000.00 bonus in the DI/AP races.
2. All other horses which do not comply with the conditions as set out in #1 above will still be eligible to enter the DI/AP races and they shall be eligible for the \$100,000.00 bonus upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$4,500.00 one month prior to the first race of the three race series.

2. WEIGHT IN RACES IN PART 1 AND PART 2 OF THE SERIES

Weights shall be allotted
Highest rated horse (s) to carry 123lb
Maidens allowed 7lb
1 lb per rating up to a maximum of 10lb

NO APPRENTICE ALLOWANCE

3. ENTRY FEE

2.5% of winners purse
Will be refunded in respect of all entrants not selected to run.

4. **SELECTION**

There shall be a maximum of twelve (12) runners per race.

Following entries, and in the event of the more than 12 entries being received for a race, the first twelve (12) shall be selected according to the "Points Schedule" set out below.

Points are gained by a horse as a result of its performance in races since 3 July, 2009 based on the Points Schedule. The more points a horse has gained, the higher its rank.

Where horses rank equally, for example in circumstances where:

- 1) They have an equal number of points, or
- 2) They are unraced, or have raced and not obtained any points, selection shall be determined by drawn lot.
